Overall Comments

• Interesting, well written and researched piece worthy of a longer essay at some point.

Tutor comments (in addition to first draft annotations and subsequent comments by email on second draft):

A positive and thoughtful first draft, Sue, which – as discussed – would benefit from deeper analysis into fewer points. I also felt strongly that the original title was weak and oversimplified – not indicative of an in-depth inquiry.

Your second draft is a significant improvement: better structured and more academic though could be a more analytical in places (e.g. weighing up contrasting arguments or perspectives, though this can be difficult in an essay of this length). The slight shift in emphasis - towards photography as a technological development that has determined how we consume landscape imagery, and how we perceive and interact with 'the landscape' - works well and provides the chronological arc that was needed to tie the postcard tradition and instagram together.

Pleased to see that the John Hinde recommendation was useful. (Did you find the essay guidelines email helpful, by the way?)

Your research into the instagram phenomenon could prove to be a rich seam of inquiry should you wish to pursue this further at Level 3.

Well done for pursuing a second draft despite having to cope with some difficult personal circumstances. I look forward to discussing your 5th assignment.

Feedback on assignment

- Good introduction, though content supersedes title suggest title be reframed to better fit with the essay content.
- Good sub heading structure
- Suggest extending introduction to reference later arguments in the main body
 of the essay, such as tourist photography being performed rather than
 preformed, the technology driven selfie, role of technological determinism,
 and ways in which image-based desire fuels our consumerist culture (as
 described later in the essay and illustrated by your reference to the early
 example of Hinde's saturated colour which parallels advertising). Scopic
 desire /images feeding into & perpetuating culture of acquisitiveness worth
 mentioning in general terms as context
- Reference to own work would perhaps better fit as a footnote and changed to third person to be consistent
- Show a clearer link on page 3 between the modes of transport leading to expanded travel & (ultimately the postcard) and Urry's concept of the 'Tourist Gaze' i.e. how the world/ tourism moved on from 1840 to 2011 (the date of Urry's book referenced).
- Tie in conclusion to expanded introduction.
- Effective use of quotes / referencing. Refer query re including bibliography to OCA librarian.
